

NEW MEXICO DISTRICT KIDS CAMP CHECKLIST & INFO PAGE

Q. What do we need to bring to camp?

- Bible
- Swimming suit (One piece suits only)
- Bed linens/sleeping bag
- Towels (One for swimming, one for bathing)
- Toiletry items
- Flashlight
- Hiking or tennis shoes
- Flip flops (for walking to/from the pool)
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Jacket
- Umbrella
- Camera
- Plastic bag for dirty or wet clothes
- Any prescription meds in the original packaging, with instructions for the Nurse.

Q. What is not allowed at camp?

A. Alcohol, clothing with vulgar or offensive graphics, recreational/illegal drugs, tobacco products, two-piece bathing suits, and fireworks.

NOTE: Cell phone service is often not available at Bonita Park. In addition Wi-Fi access via personal electronics puts all our kids at risk of being exposed to unprotected situations. Please consider keeping all of your child's electronic devices at home for the week. If your child must bring a cell phone, tablet, gaming device, or any other electronic, his/her counselor will keep it safe in his/her care throughout the week.
