- Most of our pastors have been doing heroic work to help our churches to stay afloat and vibrant during these days of pandemic-amonium. I am so proud of the way they have stepped into the unknown and have lead thriving ministries during these months. If you are a church leader, please express appreciation to your pastor(s) in meaningful ways and make sure they take some time off to recharge.
- While we may be getting back to church to some degree, it will be a long time before things get back to normal. Continue to be patient and recognize that the way we do church may be forever changed. Let's think not about how to get back to the way things were, but how to go forward to the way things need to be. I believe this is a great time to see true re-formation in the church. If you need my permission to try something completely new, you have it. Remember to let Mission drive method.
- Continue to watch out for the most vulnerable in your church. There may be many people who will not feel safe to get out for some time. Do not forget them. Find ways to continue to include them, even if they don't feel safe coming together.
- Start keeping a record of ministry contacts. I do not know when we will start counting as we used to do; however, this is a good time to learn to count what counts—the total impact of the ministry of your church. Start keeping a record of all the people the church makes intentional connections with for the sake of the gospel each week. You may discover that your church is way more effective than you even knew.

District Assembly is our next big event. It will take on a different flavor this year as we will have our delegates join remotely and will try to be very efficient in the conducting of business. I think it will also be a lot of fun trying some new things. Pastors and delegates should be on the lookout for instructions regarding registration, participation, and voting. Thanks for all you are and all you do for the Church, the District, and the Kingdom. God is honoring our efforts. Pray that the harvest will still come in.


Darryl Tennefos has been diagnosed with esophageal cancer. They are working with doctors to determine the best course of action.

• We will be holding our Conventions and Assembly virtually on **Friday June 26**. Our primary platform will be Zoom and we will also broadcast the events via Facebook or YouTube.

• We will be asking delegates to gather together in their home churches or in another venue to participate if possible. Pastors should arrange delegates so that they are appropriately socially distanced, but still in view of the camera. The meeting itself will work best if projected on the screen.

• The Conventions and Assembly will be hosted by Farmington Crossroads, but we are asking that only essential personnel actually go to Farmington.
