As we come into March 2021, I am recalling that it was exactly a year ago when we first learned of "Coronavirus," "pandemic," "masks," and "social distancing." At that time, we had no idea what kind of year we were in for. I believed that we would be open by Easter, and encouraged you to prepare for that. Then, I hoped that we would be open by Pentecost, open by Assembly, open by Family Camp, and so on. What a frustrating yoyo year it has been for all of us. Yet, there was hope.

Each of our churches rallied to the challenge and continued to improve the digital delivery of their services. Each of our churches worked to find ways to keep people connected to the life of the church and to the life of Christ in the process. Each of our churches learned ways to meet and do life together without the privilege of hugs, handshakes, and breaking bread together. You have found way to declare the hope we have in Christ, even when times are difficult.

We have suffered sorrow and sadness as COVID has taken the lives of people who are dear to us and as others went into the arms of Jesus without family surrounding them with love, kisses, and hymns. Yet, we have boldly proclaimed hope, even when we couldn't gather for funerals with more than a few family members. We have celebrated that hope we have in Christ knowing, "In fact, we are confident, and we would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord," (2 Cor. 5:6). Even in times of deep distress, we boldly proclaim hope.

Now, we are daring to hope that this virus will be put on the run through vaccinations that have been made available. We are daring to hope for the reopening of our churches and the return of the "flock." We are not sure how long that will take—a few weeks to a few months—yet, we are thankful for those who have worked so diligently and sacrificially to help us turn this corner.

Now, we are in the second Lenten season with Covid-19 in the picture. I'm not sure that I can promise you that you will be back in your churches by Easter or Pentecost. I hope that, soon, and very soon, the church will be back in full swing. Still, our primary business has not changed, has it? We are in the business of declaring the hope of heaven.

So, while Covid may still be on our minds, there is Hope to declare. While people are still suffering physically, economically, and emotionally, the is still Hope to declare. While we are getting tired of social distancing, isolation, and separation, there is still Hope to declare. While there is great work to be done to regather what has been lost this year, there is Hope to declare. So, declare the Hope we have in Christ—loudly, proudly, and unapologetically. Declare it from pulpits, parking lots, and digital platforms. Declare Hope, not politics. Declare Hope, not frustration. Declare Hope, not discouragement. Declare hope, not darkness. Declare Christ, the hope of Glory and seize this opportunity to make Him known in every place possible.




