## Mission Reflections

If you were a part of the 21 days of prayer and fasting that took place in January, you know that I encouraged you and your churches to think about the next “new thing” that God would be doing. I am excited about the new things that He is orchestrating on the New Mexico District. We are hosting a Church Planting Essentials course on Feb. 5-6 because God is calling several of our churches to plant new churches around the district. I have heard several of our churches talk about new horizons of ministry that God is talking to them about and new “target groups” that He is asking them to engage for the Kingdom. I am so proud of the new things everyone has been trying in order to continue missional effectiveness during these difficult days. God is, indeed, up to something and I can hardly wait for it to be revealed. As you are having the conversation about what’s next with your church and leadership, here are some things that I would suggest you keep in mind.

1. Technology is going to be more central, rather than tangential to the way the church reaches its community. People will expect to connect to the church in new ways.
2. “High touch” is the wave of the coming church. Churches will be expected to be less focused on the “big show” and more focused on making a difference in individual lives.
3. Mission will be everything. Churches will be expected to know their mission, be on mission, and to make a missional impact on their communities. People will get involved in mission before they decide to come to church.
4. We will move from programs to Presence. People who come to and stay at church will do so because they sense the presence of God, not just because there are great programs for all ages.
5. The church will be more diffuse. There will be fewer grand churches and a growing multitude of small groups of people gathering together in all sorts of places, not to do church, but to be the church.
6. The generations we are trying to reach will expect that the church is doing something to bring justice and mercy to the community. The church must get “out there” if it expects to have anyone show up “in there.”
7. And finally, if it ain’t authentic, they won’t buy it. Glitz and gleam will not reach people. People will expect us to be real, not perfect, to be honest, not flawless, to be broken, not veneered.

Below are a few of the highlights from the last couple of months, Maria, 81, faithfully comes to bible study and volunteers at our small thrift store as long as she has energy and her legs keep going. Not only is that remarkable alone but more remarkable is her persevering prayer for a troubled man, Ramiro (name change), who broke into our store and has a no trespass order at Nueva, finally are reaping fruit! Ramiro is a new man. He isn't the skinny, dirty, red flushed eyes, aggressive and demanding person that he used to be. This time he was clean, gained some weight and came to return something valuable that didn't belong to him. God challenged us to not give up on him because he never gives up on us. Maria's prayers reached heaven. There are a lot of Ramiros, Ronnies, Davids on the streets... our hearts ache for them. We constantly ask. What would Jesus do? Dale, the most recent homeless man, got a multi-color evangelism hat with the gospel story. Ruth shared food, clothing and overall love, hope and acceptance. He was thankful someone care enough for him, didn't judge him quickly and instead gave him a pile of good frozen pizza which he quickly devoured. Omar, a young Hispanic man, had wandered away from the Lords path, though he came to the Lord, and to Nueva's ministry as a kid. He faced so many challenges and limitations growing up, being raised by grandma alone. Yet that cold morning, he received one of the Christmas boxes and shared some of his struggles. In a few minutes he was sobbing and asking Jesus to help him and to forgive him. He was encouraged to keep trusting in the Lord, who never gives up on anyone, and to fix his eyes on him not in the stormy waters we have all around us. Would you help us by praying for all these individuals, Christmas miracles, and families in Bernalillo? At a personal note, thank you for your prayers on behalf of my close and extended family. My dad, in South Mexico, is declining as he's fighting advanced cancer though he is receiving radio and chemotherapy to alleviate his pain. He knows where he is heading! ## Sandra Lopez has passed away

Sandra López, 47, of Las Cruces, New Mexico, passed away from complications due to COVID-19 on 20 January 2021. She was the wife of Benjamín López, superintendent of the Southwest Latin American District. Sandra was born 12 April 1974 in Mexico City, Mexico, to José Emiliano Pérez Juárez and Adela Maya García. After immigrating to the United States, she met Benjamin at Tucson West Nazarene Church in Arizona, when Benjamin became the youth pastor. They worked together in the youth department and fell in love, marrying two years later in 1990. While serving in Arizona, Sandra gave birth to two of their daughters. In 1996, they moved to Las Cruces, New Mexico, where Benjamin had been named pastor of Iglesia Del Nazareno Vida Abundante, where he still leads. In 2016 Benjamin was elected as superintendent of the South West Latin American District.



Sandra served most recently as the district's missions president. "Only heaven knows what a wonderful and eternal impact her years of faithful prayers have had on Ben, her family, her friends, the SW Latin American District, and the world at large," said Bob Broadbooks, director of the USA/Canada Region. "Her signature gift of sharing God's love to all people will never be forgotten." Sandra's favorite things to do were cook, read, and spend time in nature, but most of all, she loved spending time with her four grandchildren. She cared for people with special needs until 2014 she could no longer work due to a medical condition. Her smile was infectious. When I met Sandra for the first time, I noticed her beautiful smile," Carol Broadbooks, Bob Broadbooks' wife. "You wanted to spend time with her. Very quickly you discovered she was a kind, loving, compassionate, Christian woman who devoted herself to Ben, her family, and God." She is survived by her husband, Benjamín López; her parents, Adela and Emiliano; her brothers, Yaros and Jimmy Pérez; her daughters, Berenice Figueroa and Sandra and Estefanía López; and her beloved grandchildren, Aidan, Ozzy, Benji, and Arely. A private memorial was held on Jan. 25.







We are blessed the Lord allowed us to continue our work throughout 2020. Additionally, he has found us worthy of more responsibilities - Diane will add the position of regional NMI coordinator to her ministry service.

As we are unable to return to South Asia at this time, we are relocating to housing at the Regional office in Busingen am Hochrhein, Germany. This new assignment requires us to have an automobile.

This is a great expense – \$22,500 USD for a used car. Your kindness to us through prayers and support has been so great we hesitate to ask for more.
